





Each day's lesson uses the Big Book to familiarize children with traditional rhymes and chants from various cultures and introduce children to the letters of the alphabet.



Balanced Literacy

Build understanding of this week's texts so that you can best support children in making connections, learning key concepts, and becoming lifelong readers.





<u>Reading</u>

During this week, we will read with one to one and small group reading sessions. During these sessions, children will be building their reading skills.

Fluency which is the ability to speak or write a language easily, well, and quickly, is important because it builds a bridge between word recognition and comprehension. It allows students time to focus on what the text is saying. They will be able to make connections between what they are reading and their own background knowledge. To understand what they read, children must be able to read fluently aloud or silently.



Numeracy

This week in numeracy, students will be introduced to the concept of decomposing numbers into pairs. This week, students will decompose the number 6. Children will learn how to find 2 numbers that sum up to 6. They will use counters, cubes, pictures and concrete materials to build the concept.




ESL Focusing on the Whole Child

Social and Emotional Learning (ESL) is critically important to become a good student, worker, and citizen. By developing social and emotional knowledge and skills throughout a lifetime, individuals are more likely to engage in positive behaviors that produce positive outcomes. Into Reading integrates social and emotional learning opportunities with module selections, module projects, and Anchor Charts with lessons targeted to nurture social and emotional development.

INQUIRY

The day-to-day conditions of the atmosphere at a particular time and place is called the weather of that place. Weather can be cloudy, sunny, rainy, stormy or clear. In this unit children will explore weather patterns and how people use these patterns to predict future weather conditions as well as how to prepare yourself for different kinds of weather.





Creative Arts

Creative Arts exposes learners to four art forms: dance, drama, music, and the visual arts. The main purpose of Creative Art is to develop learners as creative, imaginative individuals, with an appreciation of the arts. This week in our Art and Music lessons, children will draw, write, create art crafts and sing songs about things they can do.


