







Introducing Key Kindergarten Skills

This week, we will be learning about the uppercase/lowercase letter Tt and its sound. These activities help children develop early literacy skills, including letter recognition, phonemic awareness, and beginning reading readiness. By exploring the letter Tt, children will strengthen their ability to connect letters with sounds, build vocabulary, and develop confidence in their reading and writing abilities.














Balanced Literacy


This week, we will be focusing on rhyming words. This helps children develop phonemic awareness, which is important for building early reading and listening skills. Learning to recognize and play with rhymes also makes reading fun and supports their language development.



Reading

This week, we will be reading the story "My Five Senses". This engaging story encourages children to explore the world through their senses and highlights the importance of using sight, hearing, touch, taste and smell in everyday life. This helps children to become aware of their bodies, connect experiences to learning, and build early science and observation skills.





Numeracy

During this week, the children will develop pre-writing skills by tracing and drawing ovals and curved lines, practice sorting objects into purple and brown, and engage in rote counting to 10.

These activities help children strengthen fine motor skills, early number sense, pattern recognition,

and the foundation for writing and mathematical thinking.

















Social Emotional Learning

This week, we will focus on "Positive self-talk" which help children build confidence, manage their feelings, and develop a strong sense of self-worth.



Science

This week, children will engage in exploring living and non-living things, learning to identify their characteristics through hands-on activities and discussions. This understanding is important as it lays the foundation for scientific inquiry, promotes curiosity about the natural world and encourages responsibility for the environment.




